**REPORTS:**

BOOKKEEPER LORI NELSON presented the new Supervisors monthly report. The Board members are interested in reviewing different banking alternatives. Lori would like to present during interviews with banks. Lori left at 8:20 p.m.

ZONING/CODE ENFORCEMENT Officer Robert Patterson called Norm Ball after not responding to a notice sent to him that he has not paid for his trailer park permit. Another notice will be sent including a \$100 late fee. Mr. Patterson will be at Code Class March 19-22. He informed the board he is frustrated with the State Conference the 2006

& 2003 updates aren't out yet. He has to take a mandated course and test. He submitted an intro to the 1203 law in the Town of Bergen Newsletter he will start with commercial and public areas. He also stated that codes are getting in depth and would like access to a local engineer to ask questions, possibly sharing one with other municipalities. Councilman Miller said the Association of Towns should be able to answer any questions he has. Mr. Patterson also requested that the board check into disability insurance for next years budget. He left at 8:38 p.m.

HIGHWAY Superintendent Roggow reported the State was remilling Rt. 19 from Hunter St. to Brockport this year and the 2008 schedule would be Rt. 19 from Pavillion to Bergen. The Transfer station & Robins Brook part entrance needs more base, he is constantly fixing pot holes, and it would go from edge of pavement to the gate.

SNOW & ICE CONTRACT: Deputy Supervisor Cunningham will send a letter to Legislator Zambito regarding the 2006-2007 contract requesting that the committee consider a reissuing of the contract at the 2005-2006 snow season amounts.

SUPERVISOR & CLERK REPORTS: A motion was made Councilwoman Baker to accept reports, seconded by Councilman Miller and carried by a vote of 3-0.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

MOWING BID: Two bids for mowing were received from First Class Lawn Care for \$6,850 and Jim Palmer for \$11,000. Councilwoman Baker made a motion to offer the contract to First Class Lawn Care, seconded by Councilman Miller and carried by a vote of 3-0.

MANDATED TRAINING: Councilwoman Baker is sending an invitation to the Zoning & Planning Boards for ideas for training members.

**New Business:**

UPDATES ON TULLY BUILDING: Architect measurements were schedules for the week of March 4<sup>th</sup>, they will be shared with the village first.

**BILLS:** The bills were presented for audit and totaled \$19,500.02 for General Fund Vouchers #67-103, Highway Fund \$16196.51 Vouchers #34-53 and Capital Fund \$100.00 Vouchers #5. Councilwoman Baker made a motion to pay the March bills, seconded by Councilman Miller and carried a vote of 3-0.
