

APPROVAL OF AQCUSITION OF AN EASEMENT BY THE MONROE COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO §1096(6-a) OF NEW YORK'S PUBLIC AUTHORITIES LAW

WHEREAS, The Monroe County Water Authority ("Authority") is responsible for the future replacement of the existing water main along Swamp Road, in the town of Bergen; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of one (1) easement is necessary for the construction, installation, operation, and maintenance of a replacement water main; and

WHEREAS, the approximately [580' x 15'] easement necessary for the replacement water main is located along the frontage of 7711 Swamp Road (Tax Acct. No. 12.-1-69.112), which is owned by Justin Russell and Nicole Russell; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition is necessary to allow for the completion of the construction, installation, operation, and maintenance of the replacement water main which will allow the Water Authority to continue to provide potable water supply and fire protection to the area; and

WHEREAS, §1096(6-a) of New York's Public Authorities Law requires the Water Authority to obtain the prior approval of the above-referenced acquisition by the Town Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, let it be

RESOLVED, that the Town hereby approves of the Water Authority's acquisition of the Swamp Road easement in accordance with §1096(6-a) of the New York Public Authorities Law and be it further

RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be provided to the Monroe County Water Authority.

Mission: It is the mission of the Genesee County Office for the Aging to provide information, support and advocacy to our residents 60 years of age and older, their caregivers and disabled persons of all ages. Our aim is to promote their independence and improve their quality of life.

Agency Description: Office for the Aging provides a wide array of nutrition, advocacy, educational, social, health related, and assistance programs and services to Genesee County's residents, primarily serving those age 60 and over. Major program areas include home delivered and congregate meals; recreational, health, wellness, and social activities; volunteer opportunities, case management, in-home personal care and housekeeping assistance; medical and shopping transportation services; outreach and benefits counseling; legal assistance; information and referral; weatherization and home energy assistance, long term care and health insurance counseling; advanced care planning; Caregiver information, assistance, counseling, respite and support.

Through New York Connects Genesee Care Options, individuals of all ages are provided information, assistance, screening and linkage to a wide range of in-home, residential and community based long term care services; while engaging planning partners to address service gaps and exploring the "Livable Communities" concept.

Role of Genesee County Office for the Aging Advisory Council Members:

- 1. Be an advocate for the needs primarily of older adults and their caregivers (family members/informal supports), but also for disabled individuals of all ages in the Genesee County area; and their caregivers (family members/informal supports)
- 2. Become knowledgeable about senior services; and take information regarding programs and services provided by the Office for the Aging and other programs in the area that serve older adults, disabled individuals and their caregivers, to individuals they come in contact with and/or serve to assist others in accessing those services.
- 3. Participate in gathering information on senior needs, including promotion of senior/disabled individuals survey process; evaluation of current services; holding public hearings on services for older adults, disabled individuals; and their caregivers to determine whether Office for the Aging funding is being used to meet local senior needs

and/or to identify unmet needs that may be met by Office for the Aging, a local not for profit organization or other community agency/business.

- 4. Participate in planning and coordinating a public hearing process regarding the use of Older Americans Act federal funds, New York State Office for the Aging state funds, private grant funds and foundation funds as these funds all come together to create and maintain a system of non-medical community and in-home services for older adults in Genesee County.
- 5. May serve as a Liaison to other committees connected to Office for the Aging such as the Genesee County Long Term Care Task Force, Marshall Fund Planning Team, Genesee Senior Foundation, etc.

Application Process:

- 1. Each applicant must complete a Genesee County Legislature Advisory Council Membership form and return it to the Genesee County Office for the Aging, 2 Bank Street, Batavia, NY 14020.
- 2. Once the application is submitted, it is reviewed by the Director of the Office for the Aging and OFA Advisory Council Chairperson; and is then forwarded onto the Genesee County Legislature for consideration of an appointment to an OFA Advisory Council position, either as a Community Member (Age 60+) or Provider/Caregiver/General Public Member as per members vacancy ratios set up under the OFA Advisory Council by-laws, and outlined above.
- 3. Membership to the Office for the Aging Advisory Council is not official until the Genesee County Legislature approves the appointment through a resolution.
- 4. A copy of the resolution naming the individual to the Office for the Aging Advisory Council will be sent to the individual; and the individual will be asked to take an oath to serve with good intent and in the best interest of seniors, disabled individuals and their caregivers.
