Dear Municipal Official:

I am providing you with this notice as part of our ongoing efforts to keep you apprised of developments affecting Charter subscribers in your community.

Effective on or after December 31, 2017, WISF – IND programming will no longer be available on Spectrum TV on Basic/Starter TV and Business TV in the Bainbridge/Sidney, Delhi-Walton, New Berlin, Oneonta & Oxford channel lineups. Discontinuation is due to the station not having an FCC license.

Effective on or after January 25, 2018, the following changes will be made to all channel lineups:

BET Her, BET Jams and BET Soul currently located on Digital Tier 1 will be available only on Digital Tier 2 in all channel lineups

MTV2, MTV Classic, TeenNick, NickToons, Logo, MTV Live & Nick Music currently available on Digital Tier 1 will be relocated to Digital Tier 2 in all channel lineups



We wanted to keep you up-to-date and let you know that the GCEDC is in active negotiations of Purchase and Sale Agreement with a company "J-Rental" that is interested in purchasing 23 acres of land at Apple Tree Acres.
